

## **TAFE SCHOLARSHIP 2019**

**The National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) TAFE scholarship is designed to support women in all fields of construction.**

The NAWIC mission is to raise the profile of women working in the construction industry and be a positive instrument for change in the construction industry. NAWIC started in 1995 and has strived to build the organisation to encourage and support women in the construction and related industries.

Recipients of the NAWIC scholarship are encouraged to promote the scholarship on campus at the following year's launch, attend a NAWIC QLD event or seminar during the year the scholarship is awarded and share their experiences with the group.

Recipients of the NAWIC scholarship are encouraged to attend two NAWIC Education and Mentoring Committee Meetings (held monthly) during the year the scholarship is awarded to share their thoughts and suggestions with the NAWIC team.

NAWIC Qld will provide an opportunity for the scholarship recipient to provide input to the NAWIC QLD social media channels, in the form of either an article or short post.

The Scholarship is valued at \$1,500 for one year.

NAWIC will provide a year's free student membership to NAWIC QLD as part of the scholarship prize.

### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

To be eligible for the Scholarship you must:

- Be a female
- Be enrolled in one of the following programs:
  - ✓ Associate Degree of Engineering
  - ✓ Advanced Diploma of Civil Construction Management
  - ✓ Advanced Diploma of Civil Construction
  - ✓ Diploma in Building; Construction (Building)
  - ✓ Diploma in Building; Construction (Management)
  - ✓ Diploma in Building Design
  - ✓ Diploma of Civil Construction Management
  - ✓ Diploma of Project Management
  - ✓ Certificate IV in Building and Construction
  - ✓ Certificate IV in Building
  - ✓ Certificate IV in Site Management
  - ✓ Certificate IV in Construction Supervision
  - ✓ Certificate IV in Civil Construction Supervision
  - ✓ Certificate IV in Estimating
  - ✓ Certificate III in any Building & Construction related courses

### **SELECTION CRITERIA**

Selection will be based on:

- An 600-800 word essay on either of the following topics:
  - ✓ How can high schools, and organisations like NAWIC play a bigger part in encouraging girls to consider a career in the construction industry?

- ✓ The theme for the NAWIC Mentoring program for FY19 is accountability and self-responsibility. Tell us what these concepts mean to you in a professional and personal context, and how you would embody them as a representative of the NAWIC organisation as the successful scholarship applicant
- A brief explanation of how the NAWIC scholarship will assist you in your plan of study (e.g. assistance with purchasing text books)
- A written reference from either an employer or supervising educator
