WHO CAN ENTER

Any woman in a construction industry related position in Western Australia is eligible for this award.

Please ensure you have completed the following prior to submitting your entry online:

- ◆ Complete all required fields (including entering an attachment as required). Please provide at least one reference from a peer, client, or colleague.
- ◆ Uploaded a professional head shot photograph of the nominee
- ◆ Completed Nomination Form AND Submission Online

Creating the Best Project Award

Please prepare your submission addressing the following criteria:

- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's role within her team, her project (if relevant) and her company. State if this is a self-nomination, or if you're nominating someone else.
(max 100 words) [Non-weighted]
- ◆ Describe how the nominee has demonstrated best practice through a contribution to any **one or more** of the following:
 - ◆ Establishing the project needs or scope through the briefing phase and/or business case development;
 - ◆ Helping develop and define a project scope that meets the brief and is also cost effective and value for money;
 - ◆ Developed contractual, commercial or procurement approaches that result in value for money, high quality, improved market practices or which mitigate risk for the project;
 - ◆ Proposed a solution that generated time savings or minimisation disruption during delivery;
 - ◆ Established and/or managed a project team that demonstrates a high performance-high-performance culture;
 - ◆ Created a unique product or process which is new to the market or is a "first" of its kind;
 - ◆ A commitment to quality and ensuring quality considerations are embedded into the project;
 - ◆ The successful management of complex components or interfaces of a project; or
 - ◆ Any other project initiatives which you consider relevant.
(max 250 words) [Weighting 40%]
 - ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through the nominee's contribution to a particular project or role generally. If the nomination is in relation to a project, the project must have been in either its planning, construction, or operation phase at some point during the last 3 years.
- ◆ Describe the nominee's achievements on the project and how she reached them. Provide measurable and non-measurable examples of achievements to date.
(max 200 words) [Weighting 30%]
- ◆ Provide information outlining any unusual or unique features, restrictions, complexities of the project and how they were overcome.
(max 200 words) [Weighting 30%]

Supporting information (e.g. client testimonial) may be attached separately and in addition to the word limit.
