Any woman working in the construction industry who has implemented a truly innovative idea is eligible for this award.

- ◆ Uploaded a professional head shot photograph of the nominee
- ◆ Completed Nomination Form AND Submission Online

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Please prepare your submission addressing the following criteria:

- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's role within the team, the project (if relevant) and the company. State if this is a self-nomination, or if you are nominating someone else.  
(max 100 words) [Non-weighted]
- ◆ Describe how the nominee has demonstrated significant innovation and success in her role. This could be through any one or more of the following:
  - ◆ Proposing unique or innovative contractual, commercial or procurement approaches;
  - ◆ Establishing an innovative practice within an organisation;
  - ◆ Implementing an innovative practice within the construction industry;
  - ◆ Demonstrating the positive impact of an innovative process on the workforce, an organisation, client, or community;
  - ◆ Thinking outside the box, to respond effectively to client needs;
  - ◆ Introducing successful innovation to any part of the construction process resulting in exceeding client satisfaction, by providing value for money, reduction in program or technical complexity.  
(max 650 words) [Weighting 100%]
- ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through the nominee's contribution to a particular project or her role generally. If the nomination is in relation to a project, the project must have been in either its planning, construction, or operation phase at some point during the last 3.
