Outstanding Achievement In Safety Award

Please prepare your submission addressing the following criteria:

- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's role within the team, the project (if relevant) and the company. State if this is a self-nomination, or if you are nominating someone else.
(max 100 words) [Non-weighted]
- ◆ Describe how the nominee has achieved one or more of the following:
 - ◆ Establishing and implementing a company policy or initiating legislative changes in respect to safety;
 - ◆ Actively promoting the inclusion of safety principles and initiatives in a construction project or across an organisation operating in the construction industry;
 - ◆ Achieving a position of influence and authority which has enabled them to influence and/or make policy decisions in respect of safety either within their own organisation or more broadly in the industry; or
 - ◆ Developing and using innovative practices to achieve an excellent safety record in respect of a construction project.
(max 325 words) [Weighting 70%]
- ◆ Explain the impact of the nominee's safety practices on the workforce, a project, a community environment and surrounding communities or an organisation. Provide measurable and non-measurable examples of her achievements to date.
(max 325 words) [Weighting 30%]
- ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through the nominee's contribution to a particular project or her role generally. If the nomination is in relation to a project, the project must have been in either its planning, construction, or operation phase at some point during the last 3 years.

Supporting information (e.g. client testimonial) may be attached separately and in addition to the word limit.
