Outstanding Contribution to Construction Award

Please prepare your submission addressing the following criteria:

- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's role within her team, the project (if relevant) and company. State if this is a self-nomination, or if you are nominating someone else.
(max 100 words) [Non-weighted]
- ◆ Describe how the nominee has demonstrated best practice through a contribution to any **one or more** of the following:
 - ◆ The management of a construction delivery team that demonstrates a high-performance culture;
 - ◆ New approaches to procuring project trade packages or materials – e.g., strategic alliances;
 - ◆ Outstanding management of subcontractors and suppliers – developing and forging collaborative relationships or partnering agreements;
 - ◆ Cost effectiveness in terms of maintaining the project budget through construction – i.e., Variation control;
 - ◆ A project delivered on time and on budget; or
 - ◆ Any other examples you consider relevant.
(max 300 words) [Weighting 60%]
- ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through the nominee's contribution to a particular project or role generally. If the nomination is in relation to a project, the project must have been in either its planning, construction, or operation phase at some point during the last 3 years.
- ◆ Describe the nominee's achievements and how she reached them. Provide measurable and non-measurable examples of achievements to date.
(max 350 words) [Weighting 40%]

Supporting information (e.g. client testimonial) may be attached separately and in addition to the word limit.
