WHO CAN ENTER

Any woman in a construction industry related position in Western Australia is eligible for this award.

Please ensure you have completed the following prior to submitting your entry online:

- ◆ Complete all required fields (including entering an attachment as required). Please provide at least one reference from a peer, client, or colleague.
- ◆ Uploaded a professional head shot photograph of the nominee
- ◆ Completed Nomination Form AND Submission Online

Winner receives a \$500 cash prize for this award.

Social Responsibility in Construction Award

Please prepare your submission addressing the following criteria:

- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's role within her team, her project (if relevant) and her company. State if this is a self-nomination, or if you're nominating someone else.
(max 100 words) [Non-weighted]
- ◆ Describe how the nominee has demonstrated a contribution to others or to a cause through any one or more of the following:
 - ◆ The successful implementation of a system, practice, or a program either within her organisation, on a project or in the wider construction industry;
 - ◆ Identifying opportunities within a project to lead in environmental or socially sustainable initiatives;
 - ◆ Demonstrating a genuine commitment to the community;
 - ◆ Demonstrating a genuine commitment to sustainability - the built environment or a broader social responsibility.
(max 400 words) [Weighting 80%]
- ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through the nominee's contribution to a particular project or role generally. If the nomination is in relation to a project, the project must have been in either its planning, construction, or operation phase at some point during the last 3 years.
- ◆ How has the nominee's involvement in this project / in your organisation, advanced yours, and your project teams / company's understanding of the broader community and/or the environment in the construction industry?
(max 250 words) [Weighting 20%]

Supporting information (e.g. client testimonial) may be attached separately and in addition to the word limit.
