**Please prepare your submission addressing the following criteria:**

- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's role within her team, her project (if relevant) and her company / educational institution. State if this is a self-nomination, or if your nominating someone else.  
(max 100 words) [Non-weighted]
- ◆ Provide a description of the nominee's commitment to the construction industry through any one or more of the following:
  - ◆ Demonstrating her achievements to date, including education or employment or professional development or other successes;
  - ◆ Outlining her specific contribution to the construction industry to date, including social responsibility, innovation, business development, community involvement or other relevant attributes; or
  - ◆ Describing challenges overcome in her line of work and strategies she used to overcome those challenges.  
(max 450 words) [Weighting 80%]
- ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through their contribution to a particular project or their role generally.
- ◆ How do you see the nominee as a role model for other women in the industry?  
(max 200 words) [Weighting 20%]
- ◆ Note: This can be demonstrated through the nominee's contribution to a particular project or her role generally. If the nomination is in relation to a project, the project must have been in either its planning, construction, or operation phase at some point during the last 3. years.
