### ELIGIBILITY

A female participating in the construction industry in South Australia with ideal candidates including construction managers, project managers, site engineers, contract administrators, supervisors, forepersons or leading hands who successfully managed complex components of a project.

### ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

5. Cost effectiveness in terms of maintaining the project budget through construction - e.g. a project delivered on time and on budget.
6. Any other criteria the nominee considers relevant  
Nominees to note the project must have been in the construction phase at some point during the last 3 years.

### ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

## AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE SOUTH AUSTRALIA - 2018 MYKRA WOMAN IN BUSINESS AWARD

### PURPOSE AND RECOGNITION

The Woman in Business Award recognises the dedication and excellence of an individual who has played a substantial role within an organisation as a decision maker or support role (e.g owner, management, administration, human resources, estimating, legal, finance, etc). The organisation must predominantly operate in construction, civil, property development or other relevant industries.

### ELIGIBILITY

A woman who has played a significant business operations role within an organisation in South Australia related to construction, civil, property development or other relevant industries. Irrespective of the title, the eligible person must have contributed substantially to business growth or project success within the person's organisation or construction project.

### HOW TO NOMINATE

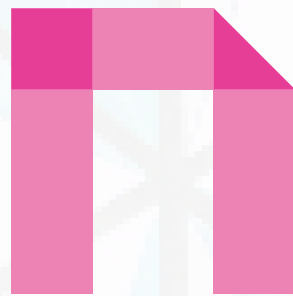

### ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

Nominees will be assessed in accordance with the following assessment criteria:

1. Provide a brief outline of the nominee's organisation including trading history, structure and operations.
2. Provide a description of the nominee's role within the organisation or project and contribution to the success of the organisation or project including:
  - a. details of the nominee's contribution and its effect on the organisation or project; challenges the nominee overcame and how this was achieved.
  - b. proactive business planning, risk management and influence on the development of the organisation or project.
  - c. the nominee's management of, and relationship with, key stakeholders; and satisfaction of key stakeholders with the nominee's performance.
3. Provide an outline of the nominee's past achievements, aspirations and goals for future participation in the construction industry.

## AWARDS FOR EXCELLENCE SOUTH AUSTRALIA - 2018 CONDITIONS OF NOMINATION

1. Nominees to address the selection criteria described on the website for the relevant award. Nominees may provide further information if it is relevant to their submission.
2. All nominees must be a member of NAWIC to nominate or be nominated for an award at the time of nomination and judging.
3. All nominees must be available to attend the Awards night on 25th October 2018.
4. Winners will be required to participate in a Leadership Panel event, post awards as notified by the NAWIC SA Chapter.
5. Members of the NAWIC SA Chapter Council may not be nominated for an award.
6. Winning entries from past NAWIC awards may not be resubmitted, however previous entries that did not win may be resubmitted (provided that the nomination complies with the criteria listed in this booklet).
7. NAWIC reserves the right to extend the final date of entry submissions, or, in its discretion, provide extensions to one or more potential nominees. NAWIC is under no obligation to provide an extension to all nominees, or publish any extension.
8. NAWIC reserves the right to use any nomination promotional or marketing material including photographs taken by NAWIC during the awards night.
9. The judges reserve the right to request further information and documentation from a nominee if necessary.
10. The judges also reserve the right to determine the eligibility or otherwise of each nomination.
11. The judges reserve the right to make no Award if in their view the standard of nominations is such that it is not appropriate that an Award be granted. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
12. NAWIC reserve the right to use any nomination in the award in promotional or other marketing material.
13. A nominee may be nominated for more than one award, however a separate nomination booklet must be submitted in respect of each award.
14. Joint nominations of up to two women for each nomination are permitted, however both women need to satisfy the relevant criteria.
