Award Questions

Nominees are asked to prepare their submission using the points below to structure their submission. Please address all criteria.

1. Outline your contributions to the industry, your company and your project. Also describe your role within your team (400 words) approx.
2. How do you see yourself as a role model for women in the industry? (400 words)approx.
3. Describe any challenges you have faced in your role and how you overcame them (400 words)approx.
4. Describe your achievements on the project and how you reached them. Provide measurable examples of achievements to date. (400 words)approx.

You may like to highlight demonstrations of any of the following:

- Attention to the quality of final work and finishes
- An exceptional safety record and/or a harmonious industrial relations environment
- Cost-effectiveness and value for money represented by the final product
- A project delivered 'on time' and 'on budget'
- The successful management of complex components of the project
