



INDUSTRY SCHOLARSHIP¹¹ AWARD

This award recognises outstanding achievements by a woman who working in a role relevant to the construction industry.

Who Should Enter?

Nominees must be 2018/19 NAWIC financial members at time of nomination. Open to women working in the construction industry.

Award Nomination Information

Nominees for this award may be made by the nominee herself or a third party who is not the nominee

1. Where the nomination is made by the nominee the nominee must confirm she is available for an interview by NAWIC judges at the nominee's place of employment or another location as agreed with the judging panel.
2. Where the nomination is made by a third party who is not the nominee, the third party must confirm:
 - They have obtained the consent of the nominee;
 - The nominee is available for an interview by NAWIC judges at the nominee's place of employment or another location as agreed within the judging period.
3. If the nomination for this award is successful, the nominee must provide a written summary to NAWIC and the award sponsor outlining how the nominee intends to utilise the scholarship, for approval. Once approved, payment will be paid direct to relevant organisation and the nominee must report to NAWIC and the award sponsor the outcomes before 1 July 2019.

Award Assessment Criteria

Nominees will be assessed in accordance with the nominee's ability to demonstrate exemplary skills in their field of work, The nominee's development to date in the nominee's trade and future aspirations. The nominee must address the following assessment criteria:

1. Give an outline of the reasons the nominee was inspired to undertake a role in the construction industry.
2. Describe an experience which developed the nominee's industry skills.
3. Provide an outline of the nominee's aspirations and goals for future participation in the construction industry.
4. Provide details of what the nominee hopes to achieve with the scholarship funds.
5. Provide at least one written reference from a current employer, TAFE lecturer or colleague confirming the nominee's contribution to the construction industry and the way in which the contribution is significant.
