Award Description

<p>Purpose and Recognition</p>	<p>This award recognises persons, businesses or organisations that actively promote and encourage participation and career progression of women in the construction and property development industry.</p> <p>This award celebrates the continuing commitment towards advancing the interests of women in the construction industry as a whole.</p> <p>The encouragement may be by way of establishing policies, supporting legislation and creating organisation structures.</p>
<p>Eligibility</p>	<p>Any individual, business or organisation residing or operating in New South Wales and who is associated within the construction and property development industries.</p>

The winner of this Award will proceed as the New South Wales Chapter's nominee to the national final of the NAWIC Crystal Vision Award.

How to Nominate

1. Register online and enter all details on the online entry page.
2. You must read and agree to be bound by the NAWIC Terms and Conditions of Nomination. NAWIC reserves the right to accept nominations in its absolute discretion.
3. Complete online submission, within the word count specified to address each assessment criteria below.
4. The online entry must include the following:
 - a. Nominee details entered online;
 - b. Nominee biography entered online;
 - c. Assessment criteria submission entered online;
 - d. Letter of endorsement uploaded;
 - e. Good quality image of nominee or nominee team uploaded (this image will be used in the Awards presentation event).

Assessment Criteria

Nominees will be assessed in accordance with how they have demonstrated (by examples) of the following assessment criteria:

1. Encouraged and empowered women in the construction industry by establishing company policy or by initiating legislative changes or other changes to an organisation benefiting women in construction.
2. Actively promoted the inclusion and/or advancement of women in the construction industry.
3. Achieved a position of significance and authority which has enabled them to influence and/or make policy decisions that are beneficial to women in the construction industry.
4. Demonstrated leadership in implementing initiatives for the betterment of women in construction.
5. Successfully broken barriers with a 'first' for women in the construction industry.
6. Acted as a role model and/or mentor for women in the construction industry.

NAWIC NSW may at its absolute discretion reject a submission for any reason.
