Probuild Project Manager Award

Award Description

Purpose and Recognition	<p>This award is aimed at recognising a woman who made a significant contribution to the delivery of a project, not limited to construction in New South Wales.</p> <p>This award recognises the competence and contribution of an individual project manager with respect to a project delivered in the last twelve months.</p>
Eligibility	<p>A woman who, in the last twelve months, has been involved in the delivery of a project (not limited to construction) in New South Wales in a project management position.</p>

How to Nominate

1. Register online and enter all details on the online entry page.
2. You must read and agree to be bound by the NAWIC Terms and Conditions of Nomination. NAWIC reserves the right to accept nominations in its absolute discretion.
3. Complete online submission, within the word count specified to address each assessment criteria below.
4. The online entry must include the following:
 - a. Nominee details entered online;
 - b. Nominee biography entered online;
 - c. Assessment criteria submission entered online;
 - d. Description of project entered online;
 - e. Letter of endorsement uploaded;
 - f. Letter of property / project owner consent uploaded;
 - g. Good quality image of nominee or nominee team uploaded (this image will be used in the Awards presentation event);
 - h. 5 images of project uploaded.

Assessment Criteria

Nominees will be assessed in accordance with the demonstration of the significant contribution to delivery of a project. Nominees must address following assessment criteria:

1. Provide an outline of the nature and extent of nominee’s contribution to the project.

2. How did the nominee demonstrate leadership of the project team, including strategic approach to planning and leading of the project?
3. Give examples of the nominee's innovation and ingenuity in resolving issues and challenges for the project.
4. How did the nominee use initiative, drive and impetus to achieve project goals?
5. Describe how the nominee achieved successful management of key stakeholders, as well as effective engagement and communication.
6. Give examples of how the nominee maintained professionalism under pressure when confronted with challenging situations.
