

## BORAL AWARD FOR INNOVATION



This award recognises the outstanding achievements of a woman related to the implementation of innovative practices in the construction industry. These practices may include but are not limited to safety, design, environmental issues, equal employment opportunity implementation, business practices, product application, project or people management, or contractual agreements.

### Who can enter:

Nominees must be 2018/19 NAWIC financial members at time of nomination.

### Criteria:

1. Outline your contributions to the industry, your company and your project. Also describe your role within your team. (400 words)
2. How do you see yourself as a role model for other women in the industry? (400 words)
3. Describe any challenges you have faced in your role and how you overcame them. (400 words)
4. Describe your innovative practice and the implementation of it within the construction industry. Provide measurable examples of your achievements to date. (400 words)
5. Explain the impact of your innovation on the workforce, community environment and surrounding communities and any consultation / liaison you undertook with these stakeholders during implementation (provide measurable evidence where possible). (400 words)

### Key Dates

Nominations open Wednesday, 23 May 2018 and close Friday, 27 July 2018.

Winners will be announced at the awards ceremony Friday, 19 October 2018.
