

CONSTRUCTION SKILLS QUEENSLAND AWARD FOR ACHIEVEMENT BY A TRADEPERSON



This award recognises achievements of women working in the construction industry in a trade.

The nominee may have demonstrated best practice and quality of work through any of the following:

- the degree of difficulty of a project or work assignment;
- initiative shown in the use of new technology in the nominated field
- ability to complete a project within the specified timeframe
- knowledge and use of occupational health and safety regulations
- the challenges overcome in their line of work.

You must submit a letter of recommendation from their employer and/or trainer supporting your nomination.

Nominees will be shortlisted and finalists will be required for an interview with the judging panel to expand on their achievements.

Who can enter:

Nominees must be 2018/19 NAWIC financial members at time of nomination.

Criteria:

1. Outline your role, project and company. (400 words)
2. Describe your achievements on a particular project and how you achieved them. (400 words)

Key Dates

Nominations open Wednesday, 23 May 2018 and close Friday, 27 July 2018.

Winners will be announced at the awards ceremony Friday, 19 October 2018.
