

## DIAL BEFORE YOU DIG AWARD FOR ACHIEVEMENT IN CONSTRUCTION (CIVIL WORKS)



This award recognises outstanding achievements by a woman who has contributed to civil works construction.

The nominee may have demonstrated best practice through any of the following:

- an exceptional safety record and/ or a harmonious industrial relations environment
- attention to the quality of final work and finishes
- cost-effectiveness and value for money represented by the final product
- a project delivered 'on time and within budget'
- the successful management of complex components of the project.

### Who can enter:

Nominees must be 2018/19 NAWIC financial members at time of nomination.

### Criteria:

1. Outline your contributions to the industry, your company and your project. Also describe your role within your team. (400 words)
2. How do you see yourself as a role model for other women in the industry? (400 words)
3. Describe any challenges you have faced in your role and how you overcame them. (400 words)
4. Describe your achievements on the project and how you reached them. Provide measurable examples of your achievements to date. (400 words)
5. Detail how you have achieved best practice on the project. (400 words)

### Key Dates

Nominations open Wednesday, 23 May 2018 and close Friday, 27 July 2018.

Winners will be announced at the awards ceremony Friday, 19 October 2018.
