- the technical complexity of the project the beneficial impact upon the consumer, owner, environment and surrounding communities
- effective consultation and liaison with the user and other parts of the industry
- value for money and cost-effectiveness
- introduce successful innovation of the process or design
- client satisfaction.

Who can enter:

Nominees must be 2018/19 NAWIC financial members at time of nomination.

Criteria:

1. Outline your contributions to the industry, your company and your project. Also describe your role within your team. (400 words)
2. How do you see yourself as a role model for other women in the industry? (400 words)
3. Describe any challenges you have faced in your role and how you overcame them. (400 words)
4. Describe your achievements on the project and how you reached them. Provide measurable examples of your achievements to date. (400 words)
5. Detail how you have achieved best practice in design. (400 words)

Key Dates

Nominations open Wednesday, 23 May 2018 and close Friday, 27 July 2018.

Winners will be announced at the awards ceremony Friday, 19 October 2018.
